## Pastor's New Year Perspective: Seven Resolutions



Whether or not you make resolutions for the New Year, I think you will find the following list prepared by Pastor Walter Schoedel interesting. He calls them '7-UPS for the New Year.' No, they have nothing to do with the soft drink. These 7-UPS fall under the heading of attitudes and actions.

*The first is WAKE-UP-Begin the day with the Lord. It is His day. Rejoice in it. The second is DRESS-UP-Put on a smile. It improves your looks. It says something about your attitude. The third is SHUT-UP-Watch your tongue. Don't gossip. Say nice things. Learn to listen. The fourth is STAND-UP-Take a stand for what you believe. Resist evil. Do good. Five, LOOK-UP-Open your eyes to the Lord. After all, He is your only Savior. Six, REACH-UP-Spend time in prayer with your adorations, confessions, thanksgivings and supplications to the Lord. ## Reading Resolutions

Every January, many Christians resolve to read the entire Bible in one year. That's a worthy goal, but God doesn't require us to read a certain number of verses or chapters per day. Instead, he tells us to simply be in his Word — and thus be with him — so he can grow our faith, light our path and assure us of his love and forgiveness. God's Word is a precious gift, but we need to "unwrap" it!

F.B. Meyer offers this helpful advice for a new year of discovering (and rediscovering!) Scripture: "Read the Bible, not as a newspaper, but as a home letter. If a cluster of heavenly fruit hangs within reach, gather it. If a promise lies upon the page as a blank check, cash it. If a prayer is recorded, appropriate it and launch it as a feathered arrow from the bow of your desire. If an example of holiness gleams before you, ask God to do as much for you. If the truth is revealed ... entreat that its brilliance may ever irradiate ... your life."

## THANKSGIVING BASKET AND OCC SUMMARY

Forty-three families were received Thanksgiving Boxes. These families included Pantry clients, CLC families, and families recommended by church members. In all, 120 people were helped by the Thanksgiving boxes.

The congregation generously donated non-perishable food items, money, and boxes. There were 15 volunteers who helped: 4 helped set up on Monday, about 13 helped sort and pack the boxes on Tuesday morning, 5 helped with the distribution on Tuesday afternoon, and 1 delivered a Thanksgiving box. About 4 people helped clean up after the distribution. Trudy Oser made 58 blankets to include in the boxes.

The starting balance for the Thanksgiving Basket Ministry this year was \$3,427.57. We spent \$2,147.05 to buy 180 grocery store certificates (\$10 denominations) at Oak Ridge Market, and other needed food items for the baskets.

### DAILY BREAD FOOD PANTRY

In addition to the Thanksgiving Basket ministry taking place on the third Tuesday of November, the food pantry was also open to anyone in need of foods and didn't receive a basket. Thirteen individuals total (ten households) selected foods from the pantry. They received non-perishable items along with paper products, cleaning supplies, some bread and gift cards. The persons from the Thanksgiving Basket ministry received other items in place of the cleaning supplies/paper products!

We gave families with 1-3 people \$30 in certificates; families of 4 and more were given \$50 worth of certificates. 37 certificates were left over, and those were purchased by the Food Pantry.

We are grateful for all the volunteers who helped in every aspect of the collection and distribution! With their help everything went quickly and smoothly.

Special kudos to all of the fantastic volunteers giving of their time and all of God's children contributing so generously towards this ministry!



## LCMC CHURCHWIDE DAYS OF PRAYER

Every congregation in the LCMC is invited to set aside time each day of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019 for prayer. Our attitude toward prayer has often been characterized by saying, "well, all we can do now is pray!" Prayer is not the hopeless act of desperation. Prayer is a gift that God has given to us as a means to approach the throne of grace with confidence like that of a child coming to her parents sharing concerns, victories, defeats and every part of life. It is an opportunity to express the deepest heartache and the greatest joy. Prayer is a conversation between the Creator and the created...and the conversation began with God, for us, in Christ Jesus. No matter how you structure this time of prayer, let's come together as an association of congregations across the U.S. and around the world to pray! I believe that the church will never rise up until we first get down on our knees! **DAY ONE: JANUARY 1-** This is a day focused on confession. We have made our lives, our relationships – even the church – in our own image. We confess that the church belongs to Jesus and not us. We gather to lay down our pride, our sin, and our agenda and ask the Lord for forgiveness, which He gives freely and with mercy. **DAY TWO: JANUARY 2-** This is a day of petition. Pray for CLC, for Pastor Cave, for our leaders, for those who carry out ministries at our church, for the Sunday School & Catechism teachers, for all leading small groups. For those attending Bible Study. Pray for our members and family and friends in hospitals, and nursing homes. Pray for all those connected to our church that they might know God's redeeming love for all in Christ. **DAY THREE: JANUARY 3-** This is the day for vision. Pray that the Holy Spirit will again move through the hearts and minds of our leaders and Pastor Cave. That God's vision for His church might be revealed and fulfilled. This is a time of prayer for renewal, revival and encouragement. Pray for God's vision.

## GET READY FOR EPIPHANY

In his book *Awed to Heaven, Rooted in Earth* (Fortress Press), Walter Brueggemann writes in an Epiphany poem: ... this is a time to be born. So we turn to you, God of our life. God of all our years, God of our beginning.... We dare pray that you will do for us and among us and through us what is needful for our newness. Give us the power to be receptive, to take the newness you give ... There is a time to be born, and it is now. We sense the pangs and groans of your newness. Come here now in the name of Jesus. Amen.

How fitting that the Epiphany season and the new year coincide! Epiphany reveals a new King, the beginning of his ministry, his new disciples, his first healings, his "new teaching — with authority" (Mark 1:27).

We, too, experience newness, now and year-round. But newness can be tough. So we trust that God, who "[makes] all things new" while banishing "mourning and crying and pain" (Revelation 21:4-5), walks with us in this new year — and always.
